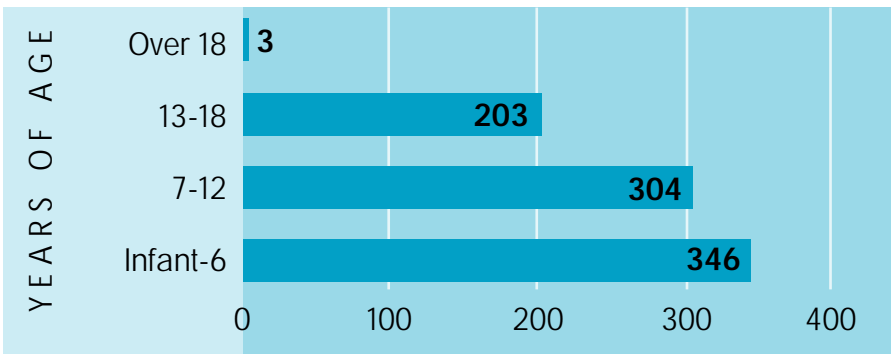

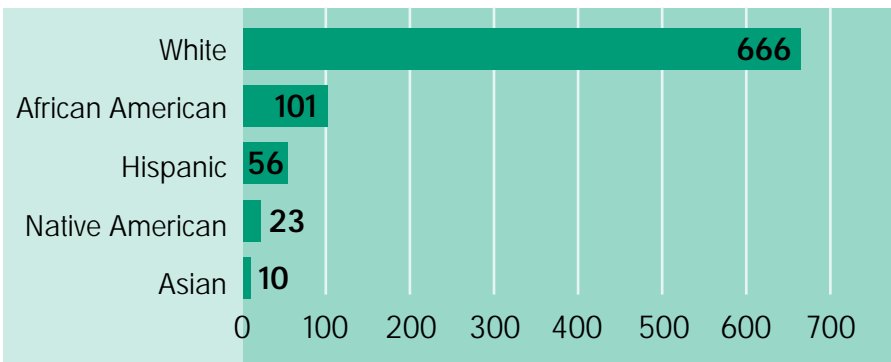

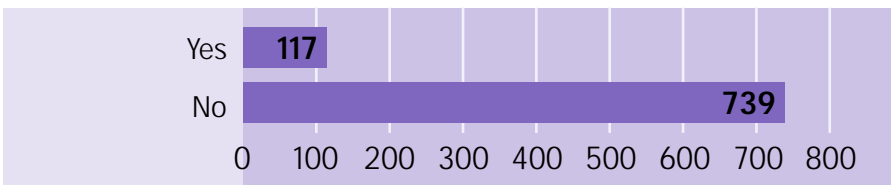
Ages of Child Victims



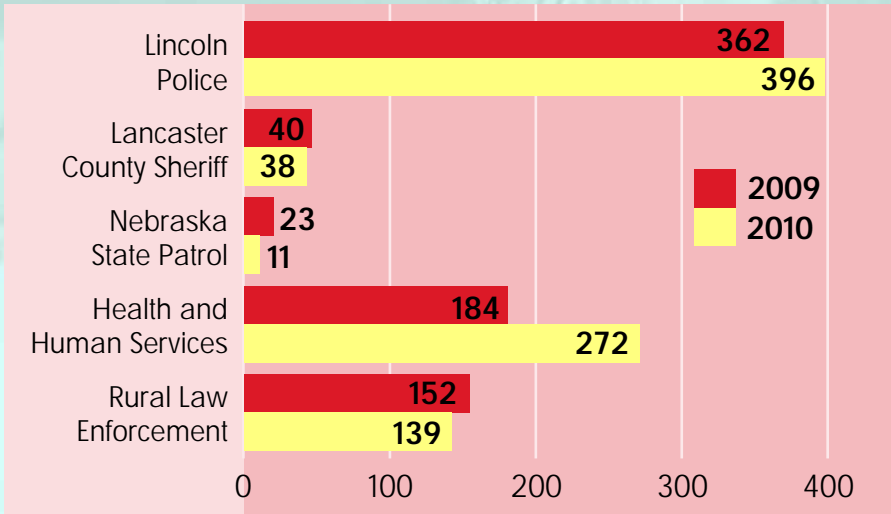
Ethnicity of Child Victims



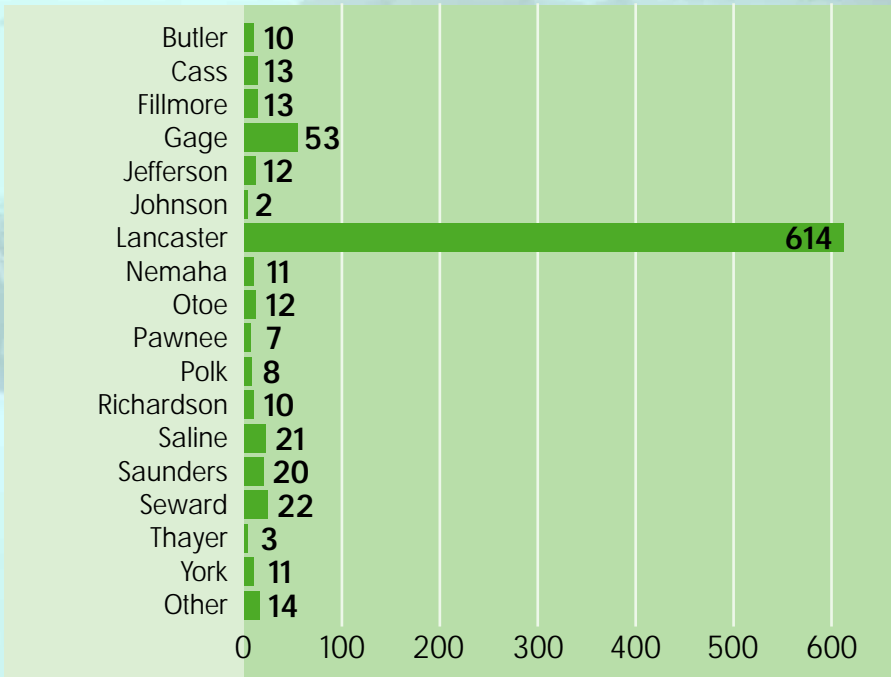
Child Previously Seen at CAC



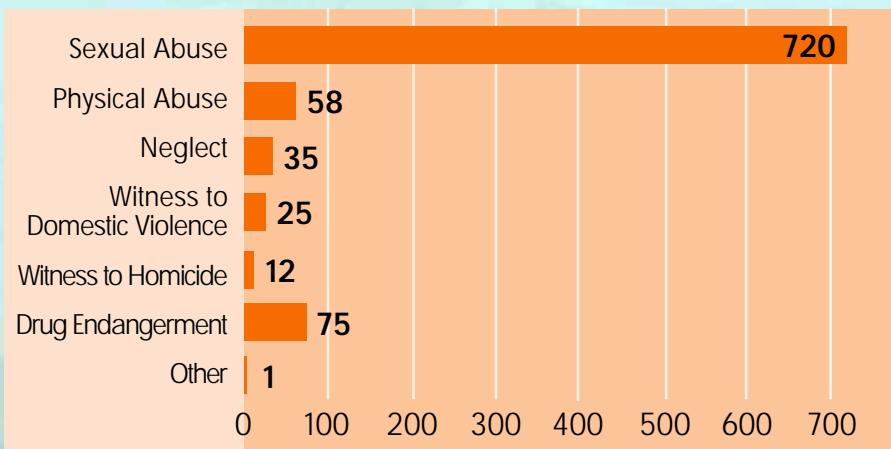
Referring Agency Comparison



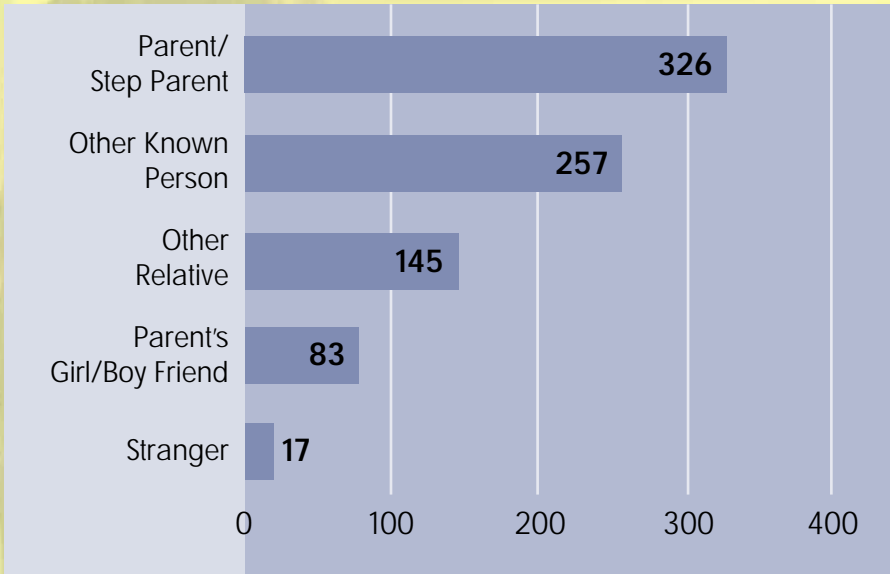
County of Jurisdiction



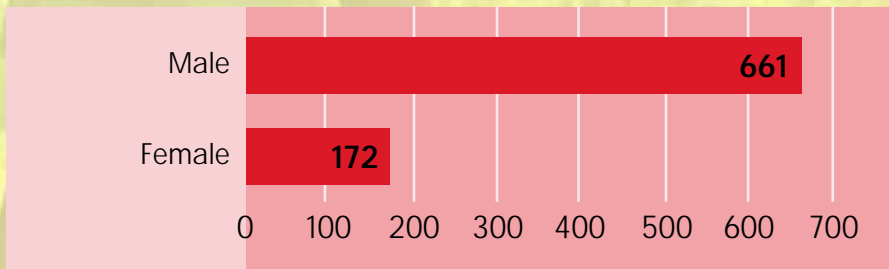
Reason for Referral



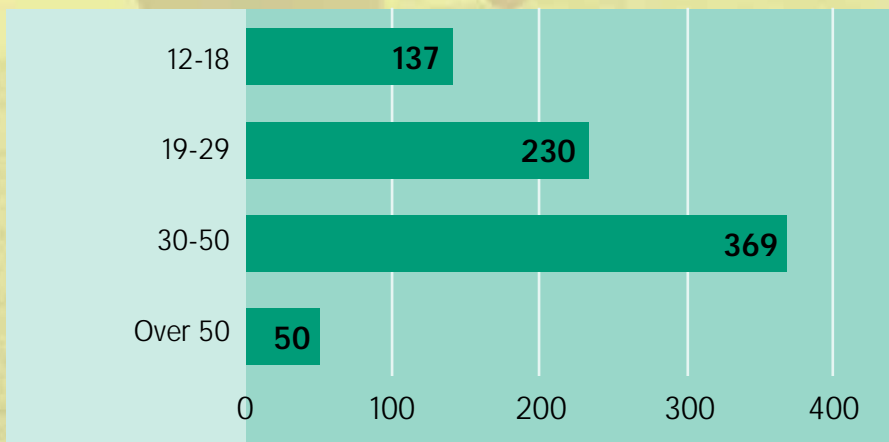
Alleged Perpetrator

Age of Alleged Perpetrator



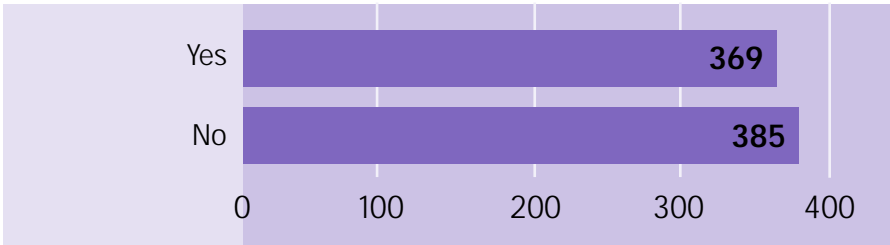

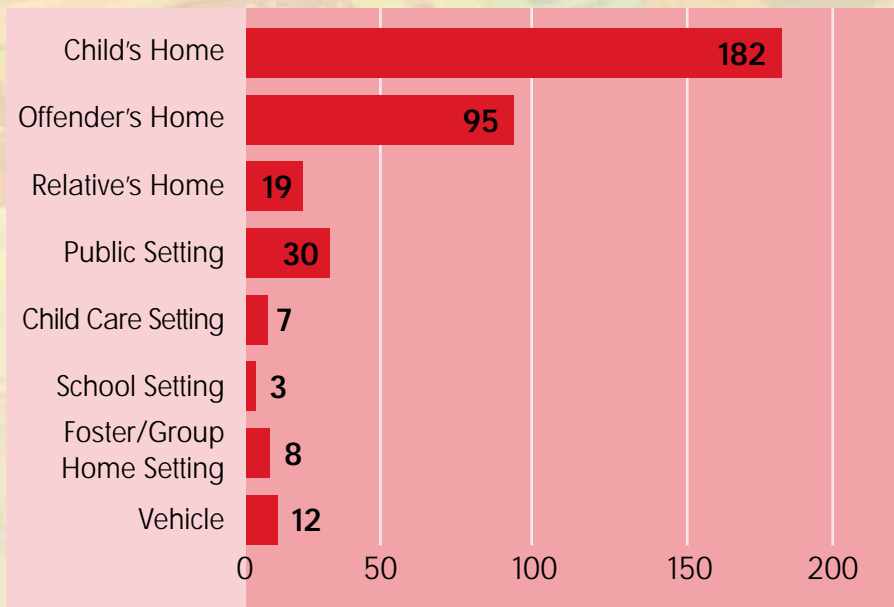

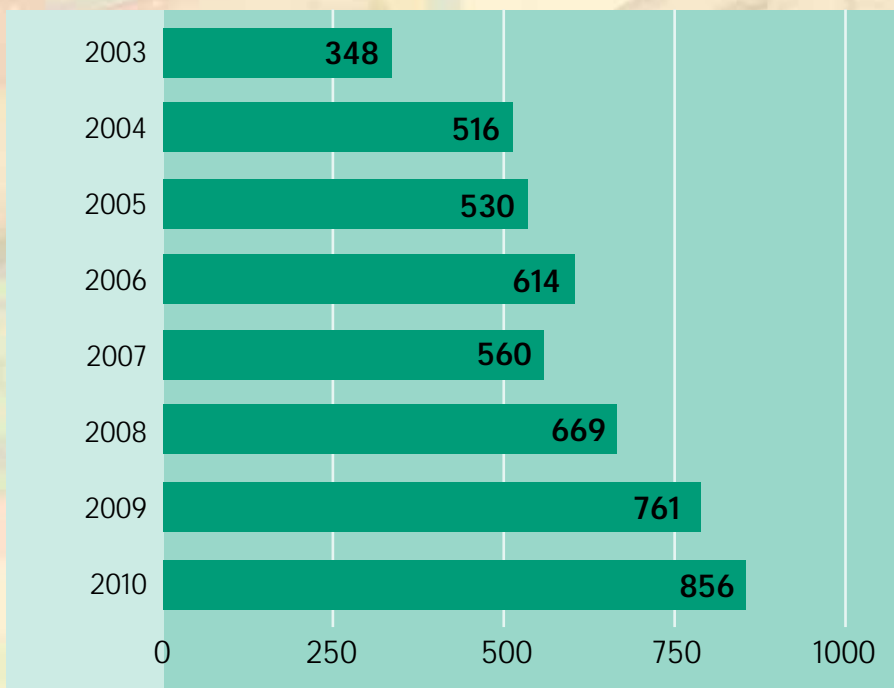
Location of Abuse

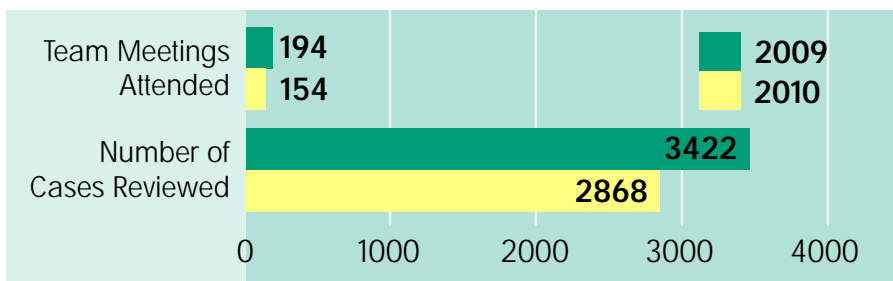
